

An Open Door to Continue to Dream

When asked, Álvaro will tell you that his favorite subject is math and that he likes singing during the daily devotionals. His eyes light up as he confides that one day he wants to be a teacher.

His face falls, though, when he's asked about what difficulties he faces.

"It's when my father doesn't have work," he says, "and we have nothing to eat. We ask God for help, for our health."

Álvaro's father is often sick, the principal explains. And when Álvaro's father is sick and can't go to work, it falls on the shoulders of the oldest children to provide for the family. Even when his father is able to work, the family still struggles.

Álvaro's older brothers have already dropped out of school to help support the family. And after his classes, Álvaro isn't able to stay and play. He leaves to go work – sometimes in the fields, sometimes doing heavy, manual labour such as loading boulders onto a dump truck. At 13, Álvaro carries the weight of his responsibilities alongside the weight of those boulders.

School is Álvaro's refuge. There, alongside his younger siblings, he gets nutritious meals and vitamins to keep him healthy. There, he has teachers who care for him, pray for him and encourage him. And there, he has a dream of becoming a teacher.

The first time I went to Guatemala, only one member of our team was a sponsor and we went to visit his sponsor child. Her teacher mentioned that she had been so excited, talking of nothing else since she'd heard her sponsor was coming. We walked along a steep and rocky path and ducked under the clothes drying on a line, then gathered around as the family pulled out chairs and stools for us to sit on. **The sponsor gave her a gift, and she gave him a hug. And then the tears came. This little girl, only five or six years old, started weeping. They just held each other and cried.** Not a word was spoken, and there wasn't a dry eye in the room. That very night in the guest house, my parents and I signed up to sponsor a child and a class.

When I returned to Guatemala to serve as an English teacher, I learned just how much impact sponsorship has. For the people of Guatemala, **the fact that someone from another country, who has never met them, would send money every month to provide for their education is absolutely mind-boggling.**

I think of the students that I taught and I wish I could thank their sponsors for investing into the lives of kids who mean so much to me. I know the teachers in Guatemala so appreciate the sacrifice people make in order to support their students, and they love those who love "their" kids.

I love that child sponsorship allows you to invest in the life of one specific child, and I love how class sponsorship allows you to reach a whole room full of kids, as well as their teacher. If you decide to sponsor, know that it's so worth it!

I'm the One being Changed

I started sponsoring a child because I wanted to help. But somewhere along the way, I realized: I'm the one being changed. There's a child in Guatemala learning Scripture I've half-forgotten. There's a classroom singing worship songs with more joy than I usually bring to a Sunday morning. Sponsoring didn't just give me an outlet for generosity. It gave me a mirror. My little brother in Christ in another country encourages me in that way. Praise the Lord!

The distance between Guatemala and your kitchen table shrinks faster than you'd expect when you treat the sponsor relationship like a real one. There's a child who's growing, learning, worshipping - just 5,000 km away. Ask them what they're learning. Tell them something true about your own life. Pray for them by name, out loud, so it stops being abstract. Something small that helped me: put their photo somewhere you'll actually see it. On the fridge, by your desk, in your Bible. You remember to pray for what you see.

Don't wait until it feels like the "right time" financially. It rarely does. What I'd say is this: *you're not being asked to rescue anyone.* God is already at work in the child's life - Impact Ministries is already there, teachers are already loving these kids. You're simply being invited to participate in something that's already happening. That's a low-pressure, high-privilege invitation. **Most of us are looking for our life to mean something. This is a quiet, faithful way to let it.**

▶ **Vida Chamché School now has a soccer field** - and it's upstairs! Lots of creativity went into providing this play area for students at a school that has limited courtyard space.
